Purpose of this poster

To provide specific examples of poster and write a few points to consider in their preparation.

Notes on poster preparation

- You can explain your poster for 10 minutes.
- The aspect ratio should be 16:9, and the font size should be large enough to be readable on a PC screen.
- The poster can be made in either English or Japanese.
- Your title, affiliation, and name should be placed at the top of poster, and your presentation number should be placed at the upper right corner in red letters with a red circle around it. (Size not specified)
- We recommend that you include your photo and e-mail address on the poster.
- Your slides should be simple so that participants from other fields of research can understand the highlights of your research.
- You may decorate the slides freely.

Poster renumbering and placement

To modify the number of your poster, please change the number in 1.87. As adjust the placement, please change the vspace in 1.84 and 1.90 to adjust.

Notes when creating a poster with tex

Basically, you can use BeamerPoster.

Example of a formula:

$$\partial_t u - \Delta u = 0 \tag{1}$$

If you set the "documentclass" to $[dvipdfmx]{beamer}$ and "usepackage" to $[orientation=landscape,size=custom, width=160,height=90,scale=1.6]{beamerposter}, the poster will look like this.$

"Orientation" is used to specify the orientation of the poster. "Landscape" will give you a horizontal poster.

The size is usually set to a0 when you create a poster, but please change it by using "custom" like width=160, height=90, and set the ratio to 16:9.

"Scale" specifies the size of the text. Please use this to make your poster easy to read. However, the title will also be enlarged. If you want to change the size of only the main body text, please adjust the text size in addition to the scale.

We recommend that you create the poster with a font size that is larger than 2.3 times the standard font size if you have a page setting of $160 \text{cm} \times 90 \text{cm}$. (This poster is about 2.3 times larger than the standard font size set for a $160 \text{cm} \times 90 \text{cm}$ poster, i.e. $1.6 \text{ times Scale} \times 1.44 \text{ times Large font size.}$)
