- To accept responsibility for payment of any debts I might incur in Japan.

- 7) To acknowledge that the scholarship awards will be tenable during the period stated in the notice of selection.

I understand that my scholarship may be terminated if I am found to have violated any of the articles above, included a false statement in my application, been subject to disciplinary action such as expulsion or removal from the university register, or if it has been demonstrated that I will not be able to graduate within the standard course term because of poor academic performance or a suspension. Furthermore, I will not lodge any complaint regarding the Ministria's judgment even though it may involve the termination of my scholarship. Additionally, in the event that I receive any scholarship awards that are not intended for my use (such as in the situation previously described), I will return said awards to the Japanese government or an organization that the government specifies.
