- NHI Payment slip will be sent to you after completing registration for the residence at the ward office
- From next year, the NHI Payment slip will be sent every year (in June)
- Necessary to make your payment by the due date: Approx. 2,000 JPY/month
- Automatic withdrawal available upon request
- A new NHI card will be sent out every year (by the end of September)



2) Comprehensive Insurance for International Student Life

"Inbound Futai Gakuso (Type E)"

- Covers for the expenses when unexpected incidents happen in your daily life

(Gakkensai 2,600 JPY+ Inbound Futai Gakuso 32,660 JPY)

It is <u>mandatory for anyone</u> <u>riding bicycle in Sendai to</u> <u>enroll in the cyclist liability</u> <u>insurance.</u> (From April 1, 2019) *"Inbound Futai Gakuso"* should cover the liability expense caused by bicycle accidents.

 Interpreter...etc.


