

"Pledge for Use of Browsing System Regarding Previous Application Documents for "JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists" Operated by Graduate School of Science"

March 20, 2019 Ruling by the Dean of the Graduate School of Science

(Purpose)

1. To improve the quality of applications for Japan Society for the Promotion of JSPS Research Fellowships for Young (hereinafter referred to as "Research Fellow") and increase the number of successful applications, a system allowing access to successful application documents is introduced to support applications for Research Fellow.

(Applicants)

2. Individuals enrolled in a doctoral program at the time of applying for this viewing system, or those enrolled (including transfer students) who plan to apply for research grants, are eligible to apply for this viewing system.

(Documents Available for Viewing)

3. Among the newly selected applications submitted by the Graduate School of Science, only those for which consent has been obtained from both the applicant and the supervising professor shall be made available for viewing.

(Application for Viewing)

4. Those wishing to view documents shall apply to the Research Support Section of the General Affairs Division.

(Viewing Period)

5. The period during which applications may be viewed shall be five years from the date consent for viewing is obtained as per Section 3 above.

(Prohibition of Copying/Photography)

6. Copying, photographing, or downloading application documents is prohibited.

(Confidentiality Obligations)

7. Persons who view the documents shall not disclose or use to any third party any information obtained from the application documents they have viewed.

(Other Provisions)

8. In addition to the matters stipulated in these guidelines, the Dean of the Graduate School shall separately determine any other matters necessary for the inspection of application documents.

Supplementary Provisions

These Implementation Guidelines shall take effect on March 20, 2019.

Supplementary Provisions

These Implementation Guidelines shall take effect on December 13, 2023.
