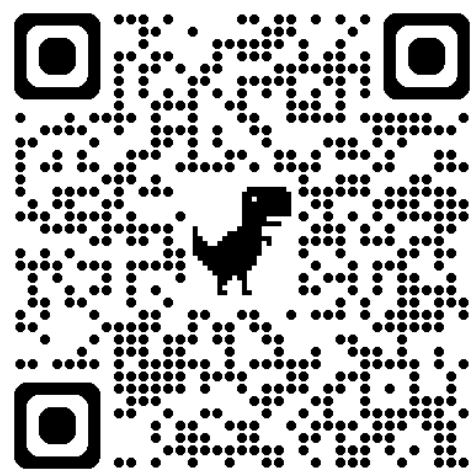




GPPU School 2026
